



WAVELL JUNIOR NETBALL LEAGUE - WINTER LEAGUE 2018/19

Rules

1. England Netball rules apply throughout.
2. Team Managers should ensure that all their players are affiliated and registered with England Netball. Affiliation sheets should be completed for each age group and provided to the Junior League Secretary on or before the first fixture. The committee reserve the right to check a player's date of birth via the EN membership website at any time.
3. All Teams must supply an umpire and names should be forwarded to the Umpire Secretary at the beginning of the season. Umpires must be level of EN Beginner or above and have attended an EN approved C Award Beginner course (evidence of participation in the form of a certificate may be requested by a committee member at any time). It is advisable that any trainee umpires are committed to following through to their full C grade qualification.
4. Please ensure you pay your umpire on the night. Umpires are directed to umpire to the skill level of the players.
5. Umpires should NOT coach a team during play. If the officiating umpire is also the coach then the coaching of the players should be limited to the break times only.
6. Special note should be taken that the Winter League is a competitive league with medals for divisional winners. Each team will be sent a Code of Conduct for players, coaches and spectators; please ensure that your parents/teams/clubs are aware of this and the codes are signed and returned to the Junior League Secretary.
7. Players may not play or move from team to team within their club during the season and should play within the age as directed in the fixture list (ie. a 12 year old should not be playing in an U11 team). All players should be affiliated with England Netball and proof of affiliation should be provided to the Junior League Secretary before the start of the season. Please contact the Junior League Secretary should you wish to discuss the movement of players within your club once the season is underway.
8. Results sheets with a list of each player's name should be completed before a game starts and handed to the umpire for completion and sign off. Results sheets should be left in the collection bin by the shed on court 1 or handed to a committee member at the end of the evening.
9. Points to be allocated as follows: 5 points for a win, 3 points for a draw, 1 points for a loss if you gained more than 50% of the winners score and 0 points for a loss if the score was less than 50% of the opposition. Please ensure the score cards are completed and handed to the Results Secretary or a committee member at the end of the evening.
10. If any team cancels a fixture the non-offending team will be awarded 6 points and the result will be as follows: Div 5&6 = 5-0, Div 3&4 = 15-0, Div 1&2 = 20-0
11. Play starts promptly at 6.00pm, 7.00pm or 8.00pm and teams should be warmed up and on court ready to play at the specified time or one goal per minute will be allocated to the non-offending team.
12. There is a coned off area in the car park area outside court 1 for players and teams to meet, warm-up and prepare in safety. Players and spectators for later games should not enter any netball court area during the play of earlier teams and will be removed by a committee member if necessary. This is for the safety of players and officials and must be adhered to.

13. The games are full 7-a-side and shall be 10 minutes each quarter with a 3 minute interval after each quarter and 5 minutes at half time. The games will start and finish on the umpire's whistle. A maximum of 2 boys per team are allowed with a maximum of 2 boys on court at any one time.
14. Bleeding: Players must not be allowed to participate whilst bleeding and must leave the court to be treated. It is the responsibility of each team Manager to ensure that a basic first aid kit is located nearby to enable prompt treatment of their players.
15. A first aider should be available at all times when your team is playing.
16. The Wavell Invitation Netball League does not accept any responsibility for loss or damage to persons or property.
17. Photographs: the use of cameras or videoing equipment during play is not allowed. You may take an individual or team shot away from the playing areas but you must have your own club photographic policy in place and hold parental permission for this.
18. Team Managers should not leave the campus until all their players have been collected by a parent or guardian.
19. During wet or icy conditions the decision to cancel a game will be made as close to 4pm as possible. Team Managers will be notified via text & email (where possible) if a game is cancelled.
